Minutes	<p><u>Discussion with Pr. Secretary and NSDC TPs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NSDC started the discussion and made a presentation on the model decided by the State listing out the roles and responsibilities of the various stakeholders. • The model finalized with the State Government is that the NSDC TPs will roll out the scheme in NVEQF Schools through the existing Vocational Faculty and infrastructure in the school. • NSDC TPs will be doing ToT of the faculty, running of labs, provide courseware and facilitate STAR processes. • NSDC TPs identified for the Roll out of the Scheme gave presentations introducing their organizations to the State Government. • 140 Schools will be covered in the first phase with two trades in each school starting from 31st March. • Approximately 10000 school drop outs, finished school and existing students are likely to be benefited from the scheme. • The school administration will play a key role in mobilizing students under the STAR • On suggestion of Principal Secretary, NSDC presented the tenets of the STAR scheme to a group of 50 Principals of the Govt. Schools. <p><u>Presentation to 50 School Principals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NSDC also presented the animation of STAR scheme and the model to 50 School Principals where the scheme shall be rolled out. • All the principals were keen to roll out the scheme and saw it as a great opportunity for their students. • School Principals suggested starting these training from March end as during March students will be involved in Annual Examinations. • As desired by the Principals, NSDC TPs will also launch dedicated batches for the Summer Vacations in the month of June. <p><u>Discussion with State Government on implementing NVEQF under Public Private Partnership</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NSDC presented a model for implementing NVEQF in fast track in over 3000 schools under Public Private Partnership with NSDC funding labs through NSDC partners and NSDC partners equip and run the scheme with its teachers
