Subject: Regarding Pre-Vocational Exposure to be given to students of Classes 6 to 8 in Govt. Schools.


It gives immense pleasure to inform that Ministry of Education, GoI in PAB 2021-22 has approved 110 Govt. Schools to give Pre-Vocational Exposure to students of Classes 6 to 8 in Govt. Schools and you must feel proud that your School is one among them (**list enclosed**).


Pre-vocational education has been conceptualized in Samagra Shiksha as the integration of work based activities with teaching-learning processes, rather than a separate add on to the existing scheme of studies of education from Classes VI- VIII. The general education teachers of languages, mathematics, science, social sciences, art, music and work experience would be involved in the organization of the skill-based activities related to the themes that they are teaching.

The Principal or the Headmaster of the concerned school shall act as the Chief Coordinator of the programme and shall ensure seamless coordination and effective Pre-Vocational Exposure to students of Classes 6 to 8 in Govt. Schools along-with Upper Primary Teachers and if needed, support may be taken from concerned Vocational Teachers.

 Guidelines regarding giving Pre-Vocational Exposure to students of Classes 6 to 8 as per National Education Policy 2020 may be seen at Annexure-I along with Suggested Topics for Pre-Vocational Exposure, Common Personality Development Activities and Common Exposure based Activities for Class 06th to 08th students mentioned under PART-A, PART-B & PART-C respectively.









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- The suggested topics mentioned in PART-A are to be taught by the general education teachers in their regular classes and activities pertaining to PART-B & C are to be conducted by them on Bagless days of the week.
- 3. Under the Chairpersonship of DPC concerned, Training of Upper Primary Teachers on the Vocational Activities to be conducted during first week of October 2021 with the help of Vocational Teachers/Coordinators/Technical Coordinators. Proper record of attendance along with Minutes of Meeting of the Training, to be shared with this office at hrmsqfharyana@gmail.com.





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
