Subject: To create awareness programme towards disability among the peers and parents of divyang students studying in classes 1st to 12th in Govt. Schools in the State of Haryana on the occasion of World Disability Day.

In reference to above cited subject, it is intimated that a meeting was called by Director, Social Justice & Empowerment, Haryana on 20.11.2018 at 10.30 a.m. regarding organizing World Disability Day i.e. 3rd December where Coordinator, IED was also present. In the above said meeting, it has been decided to organize painting competition among divyang students and their peers on the occasion of World Disability Day in all schools in the State with a view to create awareness towards disability among the community of the divyang students studying in classes 1st to 12th in various Govt. schools of Haryana. Accordingly, it has been decided to organize a painting competition among the divyang students along with their peers on the occasion of World Disability Day.

The complete proposal for conducting painting competition amongst the divyang students and their peers studying in classes 1st to 12th in govt. schools is as under:

Name of Activity: Painting competition amongst divyang students and their peers studying in classes 1st to 12th in all Govt. schools in the state on the occasion of World Disability Day.

Target Group : Divyang students of classes 1st to 12th and their peers.

Level of conducting painting competition: Painting competition among divyang students and their peers will be conducted at school, Block and District level by the Education Department and State level painting competition will be organized at Kurukshetra in collaboration with Director, Social Justice and Empowerment, Haryana. The painting competition will be organized in three groups as under:-

Group-I : Divyang students and their peers studying in classes 1st to 5th.

Group-II : Divyang students and their peers studying in classes 6th to 8th.

Group-III : Divyang students and their peers studying in classes 9th to 12th.





School level competition:

Each school of the block (whether Primary, Elementary and Secondary level) will get the participation of 25-30 participants in the painting competition and will send the painting of best 5 participants from their school. The participation of divyang students in painting competition is compulsory, where they are studying in the school. Where there is no divyang student is enrolled in the school, painting of best general students is to be sent from each school to the block..

Block Level Competition:

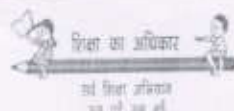
At block level, a committee comprising of BEO, 2 Principal and one best teachers of block may be constituted, who will select the painting of best 3 three divyang students as per detail below:-

District Level:

1. On receipt of the best 12 paintings received from each block of above groups, the painting competition will be conducted at district level of the selected students of block level.
2. At district level, the competition will be conducted in the supervision of District Project Coordinator concerned.
3. DPC will constitute a committee comprising of 2 Principal, one resource person in the field of fine art at district level, who will get the painting competition conducted and select 3 best painting (1st, 2nd & 3rd) from each group i.e. Primary, Elementary and Secondary at district level.
4. Total 9 painting will be selected from all three groups of divyang students.

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5. The committee will also select best 1st, 2nd & 3rd participants of peer group after conducting the painting competition.
6. Total 12 participants as mentioned above of describe category will participate at State level programme which is to be held on 3.12.2018 at Kurukshetra by the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment, Haryana.
7. One district representative along with one special teacher and 12 participants from each district will participate in the State level programme. TA/DA as per norms will be applicable under management head of the concerned district.
8. For meeting the expenditure of participants, an amount of Rs. 7000/- per district may be given from the HQ. In the mean time, the DPCs may meet the expenditure at their own level under the management head.
9. The DPCs will provide refreshment @ Rs. 30/- to all participants at district level. Further DPCs will also provide good quality of painting material (i.e. good quality of paper/drawing sheet, colors, burshes, scales, pencils, sketch pens etc.) out of the amount provided to them.
10. DPC will provide the Utilization Certificate of the the sanction amount within 10 days to HQ after completion of the activity.

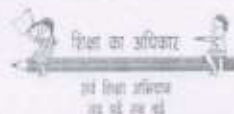
State Level:

1. Total 12 participants as mentioned above of describe category will participate at State level programme which is to be held on 3.12.2018 at Kurukshetra by the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment, Haryana.
2. One district representative along with one special teacher and 12 participants from each district will participate in the State level programme. TA/DA as per norms will be applicable under management head of the concerned district.
3. Every district will ensure to send the 12 best paintaings along with the list of 12 participants, their class and age to the HQ on 30.11.2018 before 11:00 a.m. through special messenger.
